

Refund Policy

BCBA has adopted a “No-Refund” policy with regards to all registration fees. The BCBA Board of Directors feel that due to the rapid expansion in all of the sports programs offered BCBA Youth Association, we need to be able to better manage the numbers within each sport.

The only exceptions to this policy would be:

1. If a participant decides to drop from the program within **4 weeks prior to the end of the registration** period for that activity (Refund **minus \$50 non-refundable deposit**). **Medical credit towards the next season** will be granted when there is less than 4 weeks remaining for registration.
2. In the event that the child was medically unable to participate in the sport he/she had registered for, a note from a doctor, on letterhead indicating that the participant cannot participate is required
 - i. If a parent has requested a refund due to medical reasons prior to the start of the season, they will receive a refund **minus \$50 administration fee, uniform, and equipment fees**.
 - ii. If a child has participated in a practice, but no games, then they can receive 50% medical refund minus any uniform and equipment fees.
 - iii. If a child has participated in at **least one game, then there is no refund**.
 - iv. There is a \$50 non-refundable deposit deducted from each medical refund.
- 3) If a Tryout was involved there will not be a refund **but a credit will be given towards the next season**.
- 4) If a parent can provide proof that the child is moving from the school district, then a refund minus minus \$50 administration fee, uniform, and equipment fees.will be granted.
